

Here are some suggestions.

- Coins in gold and silver are popular with the collector/investor and are limitless in range. Consider collecting local or international currencies, to coins made in a specific historical period or of a value such as sovereigns and half sovereigns. They can be easily displayed for visual enjoyment or just as easily be stored safely without fear of damage or deterioration.
- Gold and silver jewellery is also very popular with collectors, investors, women, and men, with exquisite pieces from the Victorian and art nouveau periods, as well as vintage and modern pieces that are of investment quality. The indisputable appeal of jewellery is enjoyment from wearing your collection.
- · Silver is in many forms such as tableware, perfume bottles, thimbles, vesta and cigarette cases, propelling pencils and figurines - endless styles, designs, shapes, ages or historical interests to choose from.
